

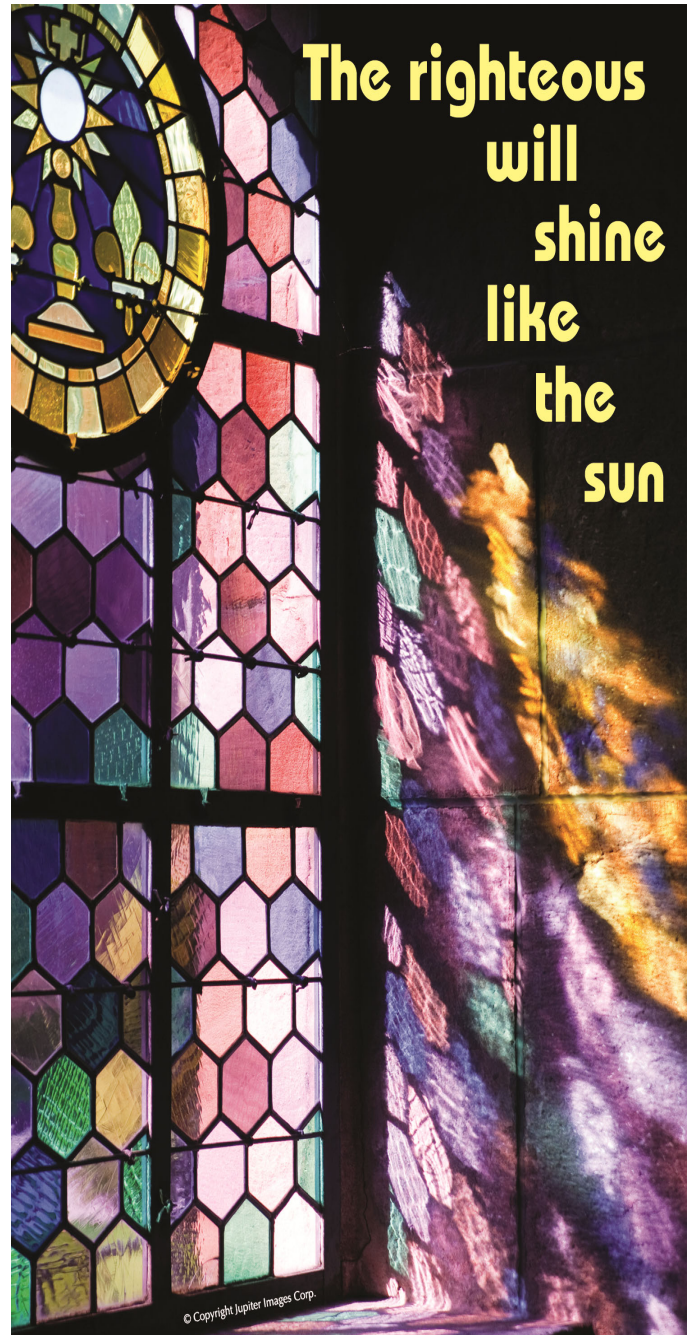

Reglas del Estacionamiento

Las reglas del estacionamiento de la iglesia necesitan ser obedecidas al igual que los señalamiento de la calle/carreteras.

Registration has already begun in many of our parishes for religious education programs that begin in the fall. I cannot emphasize too strongly the importance of registering your children early because space is limited in some parishes. I encourage you to call your parish to begin the process.

Participation in religious education programs is essential for sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation. Children may not receive these important sacraments without proper preparation. Because of the importance, sacramental preparation must be done through the parish.

Our Holy Father Pope Francis continually emphasizes that knowing Jesus and following in his footsteps is the essence of our Catholic Faith. Saint Jerome, the great scripture scholar, believed that ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ. We are disciples, followers of Jesus, and we must know Him to be His disciples. It is also important to keep in mind that religious education is more than sacramental preparation; it is part of a lifelong faith formation in discipleship.

We would look pretty silly if we tried to wear the same pants or dresses we wore at our First Communion or even Confirmation, but some of us are wearing our First Communion or Confirmation faith and it no longer fits us. We must continue to expand our faith.

Remember, what we learn as children at home and in religious education is only the beginning. Our life is a journey to God. Faith formation ends only when we reach the goal of our journey.

No puedo enfatizar suficientemente la importancia de inscribir a sus hijos lo más pronto posible, ya que en algunas parroquias el espacio es limitado. Los animo a que llamen a sus parroquias e inicien el proceso de inscripción.

La participación en programas de educación religiosa es esencial para la preparación a los sacramentos de la Primera Reconciliación, Primera Comunión y Confirmación. Estos importantes sacramentos no pueden recibirse sin una preparación adecuada. Debido a la importancia de los sacramentos, la preparación sacramental debe llevarse a cabo a través de la parroquia.

Nuestro Santo Padre, el Papa Francisco continuamente enfatiza que conocer a Jesús y seguir sus pasos es la esencia de nuestra Fe Católica. San Jerónimo, el gran erudito bíblico, creía que la ignorancia de las Sagradas Escrituras es ignorancia de Cristo. Somos discípulos, seguidores de Jesús y para ser Sus discípulos debemos conocerlo. Asimismo, es importante tomar en cuenta que la educación religiosa va mucho más allá de la preparación sacramental; es parte de una formación permanente en el discipulado.

Nos veríamos bastante ridículos tratando de ponernos los pantalones o vestidos que nos pusimos el día de nuestra Primera Comunión, inclusive los que usamos el día de nuestra Confirmación. Sin embargo, a algunos de nosotros la fe que portábamos el día de nuestra Primera Comunión o Confirmación ya no nos queda, por lo que debemos seguir cultivando nuestra fe.

Recuerden que el aprendizaje que los niños reciben en casa y a través de los programas de educación religiosa es sólo el comienzo. Nuestra vida es una jornada hacia Dios. Nuestra formación en la fe solamente termina cuando hemos llegamos a la meta de nuestro viaje.

Important Advisory Regarding Religious Education and the Sacraments

Please be advised that the only approved religious education program available for our children is that which we provide at our parish. Our catechists are commissioned to teach on behalf of Bishop Farrell and the pastor. If you have your children enrolled in any other home catechesis not connected to this parish, please contact our parish to see if it is an approved diocesan program. We have been advised by the Department of Catechetical Services that there is a catechist who provides not only catechesis for sacrament preparation in her home, but also recruits priests from Mexico to celebrate the sacraments in undisclosed locations without authorization to do so by the Diocese of Dallas. All visiting priests must receive permission to function in the diocese and Mass must be celebrated in a Roman Catholic Church unless otherwise approved by the Bishop.

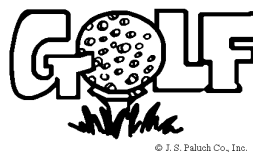
Recientemente, la diócesis recibió informes que se están realizando clases de educación religiosa no autorizadas en una casa privada y que sacerdotes que visitan de otros países están administrando los Sacramentos del Bautizo, Primera Comunión y Confirmación en lugares fuera de la parroquia. Les pedimos que incluyan el siguiente anuncio en el boletín para informar a los feligreses.

Consejo Importante con Respecto a la Educación Religiosa y los Sacramentos Les recordamos que el único programa de educación religiosa disponible para nuestros niños es el que proporcionamos en nuestra parroquia. Nuestros catequistas son comisionados para enseñar nuestra fe en nombre del Obispo Farrell y el párroco. Si usted ha registrado a sus hijos en cualquier otro programa de catequesis no asociado a esta parroquia, por favor comuníquese con nuestra parroquia para verificar si se trata de un programa diocesano aprobado. El Departamento de Servicios Catequéticos ha sido notificado de una catequista que no solo imparte catequesis para preparación sacramental en su hogar, sino que además contrata sacerdotes de México para celebrar los sacramentos en localidades no reveladas sin la autorización de la Diócesis de Dallas. Todos los sacerdotes visitantes deben recibir permiso para ejercer su ministerio en la diócesis y la Misa debe celebrarse en una Iglesia Católica Romana a menos que el Obispo apruebe lo contrario.

*Matthew 13:24-43 (shorter form: Matthew 13:24-30)
Jesus offers parables about the Kingdom of Heaven
and explains them to his disciples.*

In today's Gospel, Jesus offers three parables to describe the Kingdom of Heaven. He also explains why he speaks to the crowds in parables and interprets the parable of the sower for the disciples. This reading is a continuation of Jesus' discourse that we began reading last Sunday.

All three parables use commonplace experiences to describe aspects of the Kingdom of Heaven. The first parable is longer and more detailed than the next two, and it alerts us to the two-fold reality of the Kingdom of Heaven. The beginnings of the Kingdom of Heaven can be found in this world. The fruition of the Kingdom of Heaven, however, will not be realized until the final judgment. In the meantime, as Jesus' explanation to the disciples cautions, any effort to judge the progress of the Kingdom of Heaven is premature. Only God, in the final judgment, will distinguish the fruit of the Kingdom of Heaven and offer its reward. By Loyola Press
