Pope calls for new attitude on migration

Pope Francis in a [message this week](#) to the participants in the Mexico/Holy See Colloquium on Migration and Development stated that “A change of attitude towards migrants and refugees is needed on the part of everyone, moving away from attitudes of defensiveness and fear, indifference and marginalization.” Describing such attitudes as “typical of a throwaway culture,” he called for a change “towards attitudes based on a culture of encounter; the only culture capable of building a better, more just and fraternal world.”

Addressing directly the child migrants from Central America, the pope said, “This humanitarian emergency requires, as a first urgent measure, these children be welcomed and protected. These measures, however, will not be sufficient, unless they are accompanied by policies that inform people about the dangers of such a journey and, above all, that promote development in their countries of origin.”

Calling the migration crisis the principal manifestation of globalization and “one of the ‘signs’ of this time we live in,” the pope said, “We should be reminded of Jesus’ question ... ‘Why do you not know how to interpret the preset time?’ ”

Migration, he continued, “is a phenomenon that carries with it great promise and many challenges. Many people who are forced to emigrate suffer, and often, die tragically. Many of their rights are violated. They are obliged to separate from their families and, unfortunately, continue to be the subject of racist and xenophobic attitudes.”

Finally, the Holy Father concluded, “this challenge demands the attention of the entire international community so that new forms of legal and secure migration may be adopted.”

El Papa pide un cambio de actitud hacia la migración

Esta semana en un mensaje a los participantes en el Coloquio sobre Migración y Desarrollo México/Santa Sede, el Papa Francisco expresó: “Es necesario un cambio de actitud hacia los inmigrantes y refugiados por parte de todos, dejando atrás actitudes defensivas y de miedo, indiferencia y marginalidad.” Describiendo dichas actitudes como “típicas de la cultura de usar y tirar,” abogó por un cambio “hacia actitudes basado en una cultura de encuentro, la única cultura capaz de construir un mundo mejor, más justo y fraterno.”

Abordando directamente el tema de los niños y niñas migrantes procedentes de Centroamérica, el Papa expresó: “Tal emergencia humanitaria exige como medida urgente que estos menores sean acogidos y protegidos. Sin embargo, dichas medidas no serán suficientes mientras no sean acompañadas de políticas informativas acerca de los peligros de dichos viajes y, sobre todo, sin que se promuevan el desarrollo en sus países de origen.”

Llamando la crisis de migración la principal manifestación de la globalización y “uno de los ‘signos’ de este tiempo en que vivimos,” el Papa expresó: “Deberíamos recordar la pregunta de Jesús... ‘¿cómo entonces no saben discernir el tiempo presente?’ ”

El Papa continuó diciendo que migración “es un fenómeno que conlleva una gran promesa y numerosos desafíos. Muchas personas que son forzadas a emigrar, a menudo mueren trágicamente; muchos de sus derechos son violados; son obligados a separarse de sus familias y, desgraciadamente, continúan siendo objeto de actitudes racistas y xenofóbicas.”

Finalmente, el Santo Padre concluyó, “este reto exige la atención de toda la comunidad internacional para que sean adoptadas nuevas formas de migración legal y segura.”
