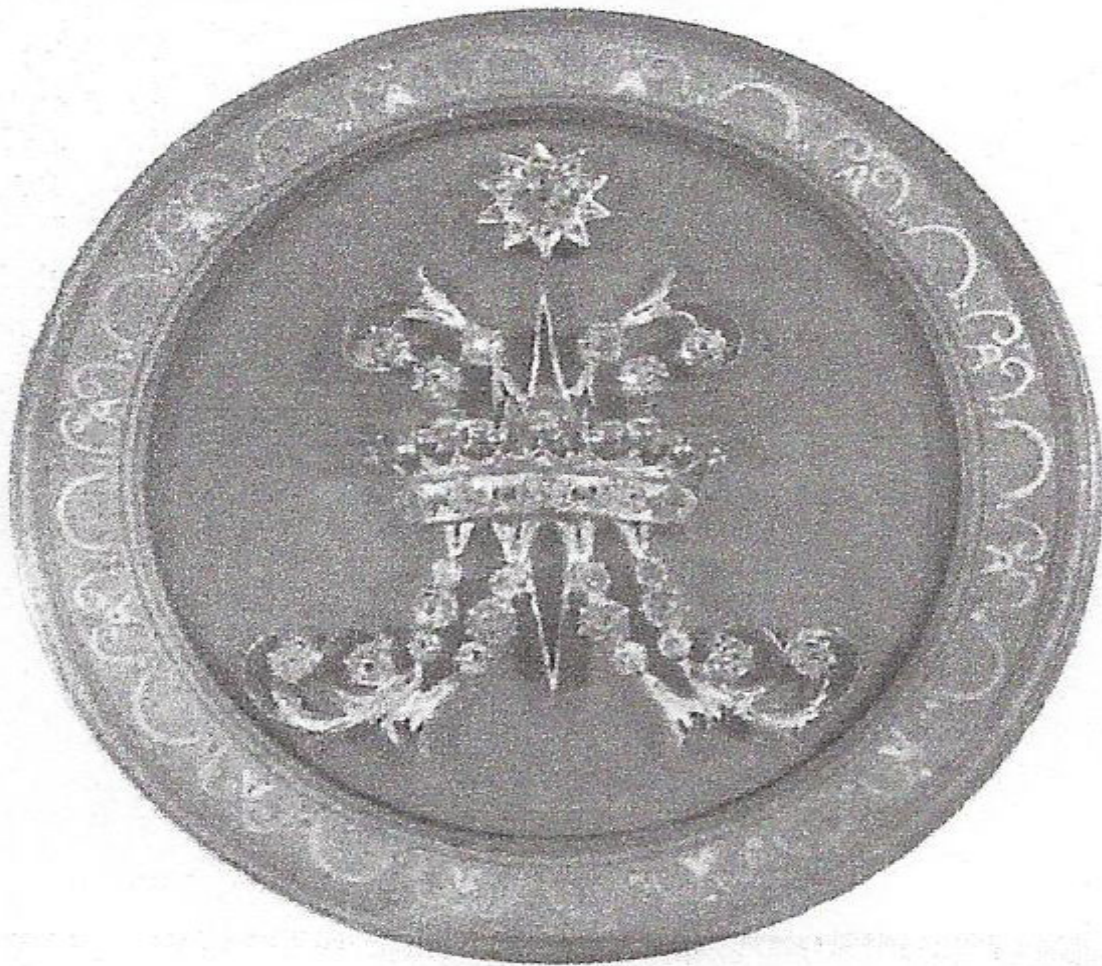

2014 Roe Memorial Mass/Misa Memorial de Roe 2014

Roe Memorial Events, January 18, 2014: Join Bishop Farrell and thousands of faithful to mark the 41st anniversary of the tragic January 22, 1973 Roe v. Wade U.S. Supreme Court decision, which made abortion available on demand in America. The theme of this year's events is "Stand4Life!" and the schedule of events is as follows:

10:30 a.m. - 12p.m.: Roe Memorial Rosary outside the Southwestern late-term abortion center, 8616 Greenville Ave., Dallas (Parking available on Boundbrook Ave. and Gaston Oaks Baptist Church parking lot, 8515 Greenville)

12:30 p.m.: Youth Rally at the convention center in Dallas, 650 S. Griffin St., featuring World Youth Day musician Steve Angrisano (Doors open at 11:30 a.m.)

1:00 p.m.: Roe Memorial Bilingual Mass concelebrated by Bishop Kevin J. Farrell and diocesan clergy at the convention center in Dallas (seating for 9,000!) with Fr. Alfonse Nazzaro as homilist and music led by Steve Angrisano

3:00 p.m.: Dallas March for Life from convention center (following Mass) to ecumenical Rally for Life outside the Earle Cabell Federal Courthouse

Bishop Farrell would like for as many families and young people as possible to participate in this great witness for Life! Everyone is encouraged to ride DART Rail -- the most convenient transportation directly to the convention center station!
