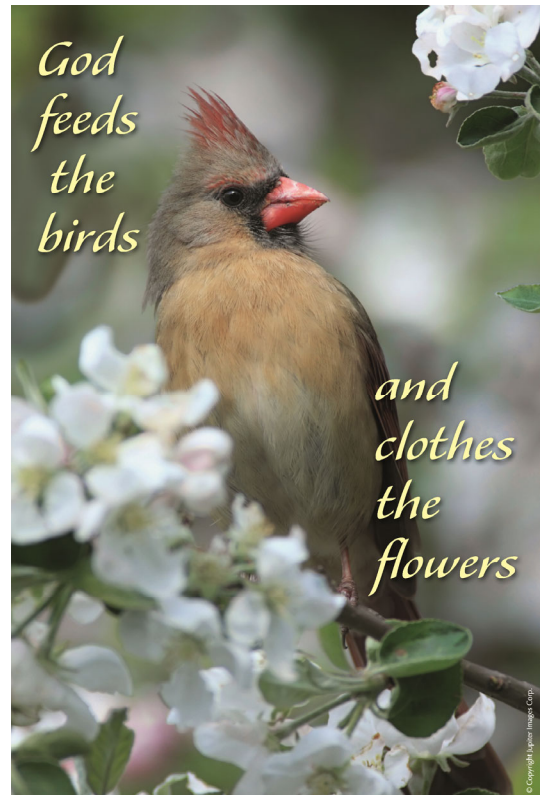

Confession: A gift of the Spirit

Returning, as he often does, to God's mercy and forgiveness, Pope Francis reminded his general audience this week that the Sacrament of Penance is "a gift from the Holy Spirit."

"The forgiveness of our sins is not something we can offer to ourselves; it is not the result of our efforts, but rather a gift from the Holy Spirit, which fills us from the wellspring of mercy and grace that surges endlessly from the open heart of Christ, crucified and risen again. ... It reminds us that it is only by allowing ourselves to be reconciled through the Lord Jesus with the Father and with our brothers that we may truly be at peace".

Asking the crowd in St. Peter's Square "When was the last time you went to confession?" he added, "If a long time has passed, do not waste another day, go, the priest will be good. It is Jesus who is there, and Jesus is better than a priest, Jesus will receive you, He will receive you with love. Be courageous and go to confession! ... Every time we confess, God embraces us, God celebrates! Let us go ahead on this path. May God bless you!"

The Holy Father continued, "It is not enough to ask for the Lord's forgiveness in our own minds and hearts, but rather it is also necessary to humbly and trustfully confess our sins to a minister of the Church. ...The priest does not only represent God, but rather the community as a whole, and anyone who seeks to confess only to God should remember that our sins are also committed against our brothers and against the Church, which is why it is necessary to ask forgiveness from them too... the priest receives this confession with love and tenderness, and forgives in the name of God."

Recognizing that fear can often keep us from confession, the Pope added that "From a human point of view, to unburden oneself, it is good to speak with a brother and to tell the priest those things which lie so heavily upon our hearts. And one feels unburdened before God, with the Church, and with a brother. Do not be afraid of confession!"

Three Little Words

As usual Pope Francis showed that great wisdom comes in simple words. In addressing 10,000 couples in St. Peter's square on St. Valentine's Day, the Holy Father said that "living together is an art, a patient, beautiful and fascinating journey...which can be summarized in three words: please, thank you and sorry."

I will let the Holy Father speak for himself in the following excerpts from his message.

Please: A kind request to be able to enter into the life of someone else with respect and care...True love does not impose itself with hardness and aggression...St. Francis said that courtesy is the sister of charity. It extinguishes hatred and enkindles love.

Thank you: Gratitude is an important sentiment...It is important to keep alive your awareness that the other person is a gift from God, and we should always give thanks for gifts from God...It is necessary to learn to say thank you, to journey ahead together.

Sorry: In our lives we make many errors and many mistakes. We all do and this is why we need to be able to use this simple word: sorry...Let us learn to recognize our mistakes and to apologize.

Jesus, who knows us well, teaches us a secret: never let a day go by without asking forgiveness or without restoring peace to your home.

Confesión: Un don del Espíritu

Como lo hace a menudo, esta semana el Papa Francisco volvió a abordar el tema de la misericordia y el perdón de Dios y recordó a su audiencia general que el Sacramento de la Penitencia es “un don del Espíritu Santo.”

“El perdón de nuestros pecados no es algo que podemos darnos nosotros mismos, ni es el resultado de nuestros esfuerzos, sino que es un don del Espíritu Santo, quien nos llena con la fuente de gracia y misericordia que fluye incesantemente desde el corazón abierto de par en par de Cristo crucificado y resucitado ...Y nos recuerda que sólo reconciliándonos en el Señor Jesucristo, con el Padre y con nuestros hermanos podremos estar verdaderamente en paz.”

Preguntado a la multitud reunida en la Plaza de San Pedro: “¿Cuándo fue la última vez que se confesaron?” El Santo Padre les dijo, “Si ha pasado mucho tiempo, no pierdan un día más, que el sacerdote será bueno. Y allí estará Jesús, que es más bueno que los sacerdotes, y nos recibe, con tanto amor. ¡Sean valientes y vayan a confesarse!... “¡Qué cada vez que nos confesamos, Dios nos abraza, Dios nos hace una fiesta! Continuemos por este camino. ¡Qué Dios los bendiga!”

El Santo Padre agregó, “no es suficiente pedir perdón al Señor con la mente y el corazón, sino que hay que confesar humilde y confiadamente nuestros pecados a un ministro de la Iglesia...El sacerdote no solo representa a Dios sino también a toda la comunidad, y aunque uno piense que puede confesarse sólo con Dios no debe olvidar que los pecados son cometidos contra nuestros hermanos y contra la Iglesia, por lo que es necesario pedirles perdón también a ellos...el sacerdote recibe esta confesión con amor y ternura, y perdona en nombre de Dios.”

Reconociendo que el miedo puede, a menudo, mantenernos alejados de la confesión, el Papa agregó que desde un punto de vista humano, para desahogarse, es bueno hablar con el hermano y decirle al sacerdote lo que tanto nos pesa en el corazón. Uno siente que se desahoga ante Dios, con la Iglesia y con su hermano. ¡No teman ir a confesarse!”

Tres Sencillas Palabras

Como ya es habitual, el Papa Francisco demostró que las palabras sencillas encierran una gran sabiduría. Al dirigirse a las 10,000 parejas en la Plaza de San Pedro el día de San Valentín, el Santo Padre dijo que “la convivencia es un arte, un camino paciente, hermoso y fascinante... que tiene unas reglas que se pueden resumir en tres palabras: ¿Puedo?, Gracias y Perdón.”

Dejaré que el mismo Santo Padre sea quien les hable a través de los siguientes pasajes de su mensaje.

¿Puedo?: Es pedir permiso para entrar en la vida de alguna persona con respeto y atención... El verdadero amor no se impone con dureza o agresividad...San Francisco decía que la cortesía es la hermana de la caridad, que apaga el odio y mantiene el amor.”

Gracias: La gratitud es un sentimiento importante...Es importante ser conscientes que la persona que tenemos frente a nosotros es un don de Dios y que siempre debemos agradecer los dones de Dios... Para caminar juntos es necesario aprender a decir gracias.”

Perdón: En nuestra vida cometemos muchos errores y equivocaciones. Todos lo hacemos, por lo cual es necesario que seamos capaces de utilizar esta sencilla palabra: perdón...Aprendamos a reconocer nuestros errores y a pedir disculpas.
