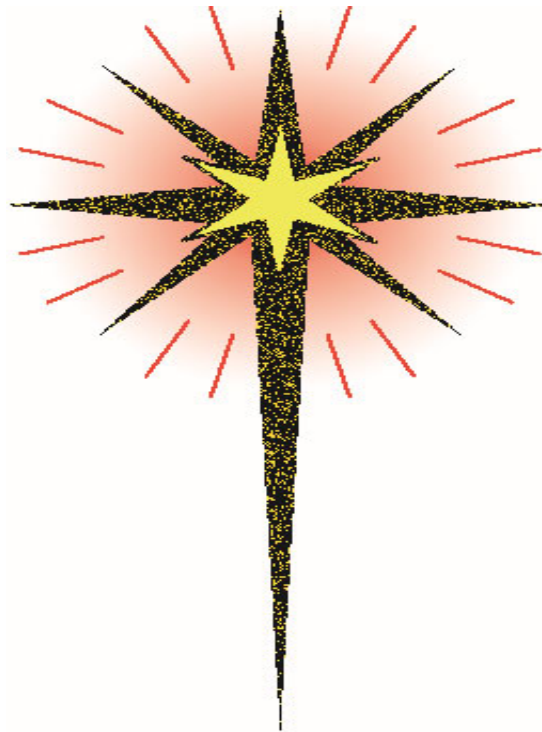

Eventos Conmemorativos Roe, 16 de enero del 2016: Acompañe al Obispos Farrell y a miles de fieles del Norte de Texas en el 43vo aniversario de la trágica decisión tomada por la Corte Suprema de los Estados Unidos que legalizó el aborto en los Estados Unidos, Roe v.
