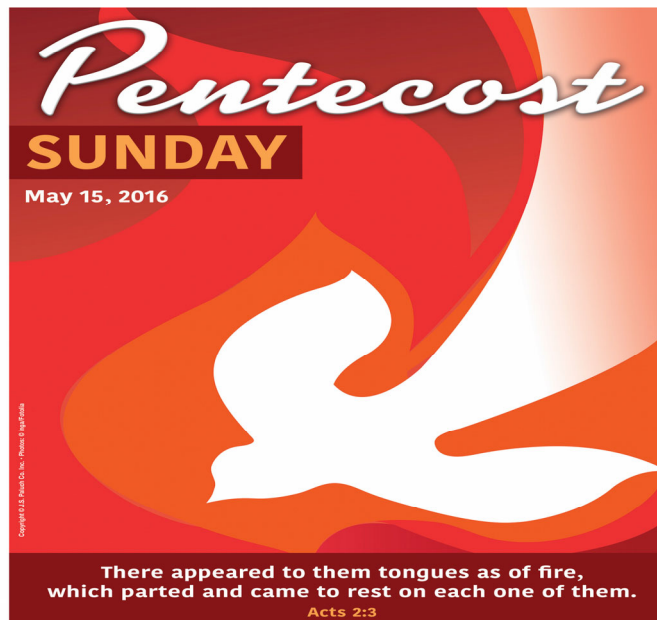

Más consejos del Papa Francisco para las relaciones

Continuamos nuestras reflexiones sobre Amoris Laetitia explorando el artículo de Camila Domonoske sobre los consejos del Papa Francisco para las relaciones entre los cónyuges. Domonoske extrae su material de todo el documento, pero el corazón del mensaje del Papa a las parejas de matrimonios se encuentra en el Capítulo 4 sobre El Amor en el Matrimonio. El Padre Jesuita Thomas Reese ha llamado este capítulo “una obra maestra” y sugirió que “deben leerlo todas las parejas que están planeando casarse y todas las parejas casadas sin importar durante cuantos años”.

Convenientemente, el capítulo comienza con el inspirador pasaje del amor del Capítulo 13 de la Primera Carta de San Pablo a la Iglesia en Corinto, el cual es probablemente elegido con mayor frecuencia para ser proclamado en la primera lectura en las bodas. La sección es titulada Nuestro Amor Cotidiano y esto es precisamente sobre lo que Domonoske reflexiona en su artículo. Les presentamos algunos otros de sus pasajes:

Nunca te Vayas Enojado a la Cama: Los Abrazos Pueden Ayudar.

Por ello, nunca hay que terminar el día sin hacer las paces en la familia, escribe Francisco, citándose a sí mismo (2015) y diciéndonos, “Y, ¿cómo debo hacer las paces? ¿Ponerme de rodillas? ¡No! Sólo un pequeño gesto, algo pequeño, y vuelve la armonía familiar. Basta una caricia, sin palabras” (104).

Trata de Ver a tu Pareja Hermosa y Adorable... Incluso Cuando No Sea Fácil (113).

El amor al otro implica ese gusto de contemplar y valorar lo bello y sagrado de su ser personal, que existe más allá de mis necesidades. Esto me permite buscar su bien también cuando sé que no puede ser mío o cuando se ha vuelto físicamente desagradable, agresivo o molesto (127).

No Guardes Rencores.

[Irritabilidad o resentimiento es] violencia interna, de una irritación no manifiesta que nos coloca a la defensiva ante los otros, como si fueran enemigos molestos que hay que evitar. Alimentar esa agresividad íntima no sirve para nada. Sólo nos enferma y termina aislándonos (103).

Digan Por Favor, Gracias y Perdón.

Francisco cita un discurso que dio en 2013:

Deben decirse tres frases. ¡Quiero repetirlo! ¡Tres frases sencillas: ‘ Por Favor’, ‘Gracias’, ‘Perdón!’” (266).

No seamos mezquinos en el uso de estas palabras, seamos generosos para repetirlas día a día (133).

La Confianza es la Clave.

More relationship advice from Pope Francis

We continue our reflections on *Amoris Laetitia* with more of Camila Domonoske's article on Pope Francis's advice to spouses on relationships. Domonoske draws her material from throughout the document, but the heart of the Pope's message to married couples is found in Chapter 4 on Love and Marriage. Jesuit Father Thomas Reese called the chapter "a masterpiece" and suggested that "It should be read by every couple planning to marry and every couple who has been married for no matter how many years." Appropriately the chapter begins with St. Paul's inspiring passage on love from Chapter 13 of his First Letter to the Church at Corinth, which is probably the most frequently chosen first reading at weddings. The section is entitled *Our Daily Love* and that is precisely what Domonoske is reflecting on in her article. Here are a few more of her passages:

Never Go To Bed Angry: Hugs Can Help

My advice is never to let the day end without making peace in the family." (104)

Francis writes, then quotes himself from 2015:

And how am I going to make peace? By getting down on my knees? No! Just by a small gesture, a little something, and harmony within your family will be restored. Just a little caress, no words are necessary." (104)

Try To Find Your Partner Beautiful and Lovable ... Even When They Make It Hard (113)

Loving another person involves the joy of contemplating and appreciating their innate beauty and sacredness, which is greater than my needs. This enables me to seek their good even when they cannot belong to me, or when they are no longer physically appealing but intrusive and annoying." (127)

Don't Hold Grudges

[Irritableness or resentment is] a violent reaction within, a hidden irritation that sets us on edge where others are concerned, as if they were troublesome or threatening and thus to be avoided. To nurture such interior hostility helps no one. It only causes hurt and alienation." (103)

Say Please, Thank You and Sorry

Francis quotes a speech he gave in 2013:

Three phrases need to be used. I want to repeat this! Three simple phrases: 'Please', 'Thank you', 'Sorry!': (266)

Let us not be stingy about using these words, but keep repeating them, day after day." (133)

Trust Is Key

This goes beyond simply presuming that the other is not lying or cheating. ... It means we do not have to control the other person, to follow their every step lest they escape our grip. Love trusts, it sets free, it does not try to control, possess and dominate everything. This freedom, which fosters independence, openness to the world around us and to new experiences, can only enrich and expand relationships." (114)

Here I might add:

The family that prays together stays together. (227)

Emphasis should also be given to the importance of family spirituality, prayer and participation in the Sunday Eucharist, and couples encouraged to meet regularly to promote growth in their spiritual life and solidarity in the concrete demands of life." (223)

Faithful love requires both prayer and work.
