These annual events are not only a memorial to the many children lost to abortion since Roe v. Wade, they are also an occasion to witness to the beauty of God's gift of life. For the first time, the Roe Memorial Mass will be celebrated on Friday evening, January 13, at 7 p.m. by Bishop Kelly at St. Monica in Dallas and by Pastor Jesús Belmontes at nearby San Juan Diego.

On Saturday, January 14, the North Texas March for Life will begin at 12:30 p.m. at Dallas City Hall with the Procession of Roses and continue to the Rally for Life outside the federal courthouse, featuring the first rally address by Bishop Kelly, as well as Pastor Matt Chandler of The Village Church, whose sanctity-of-life videos have gone viral on YouTube, plus many more exciting speakers!
