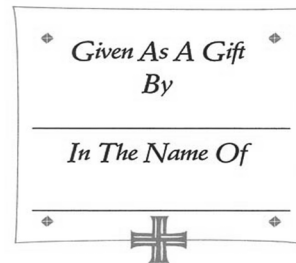

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

By the early 1950s some scholars were calling for the restoration of Communion of the faithful on Good Friday, since by then only a priest received, consuming the host from the Holy Thursday repository. In 1955 the new Good Friday liturgy was timed to begin at three o'clock everywhere, and included the option of Holy Communion, but without the Precious Blood that had originally been part of the liturgy. Today, there is increasing debate among theologians. Some feel that it would be better to fast from the Eucharist on Good Friday, focusing on the mystery of the cross and highlighting the Easter

Communion. Others say that this Communion infuses the sadness of the day with awareness of Christ's victory. It is not a day of mourning, of course, and the Passion according to John grounds the liturgy in a sense of Christ's victory over death and the triumph of the cross. The tradition is rich and varied, and we are still in the early stages of recovering an ancient way of doing things.

Why do we call the day "good"? The English and Dutch languages share this name, and its origin stems from the name "God's Friday." The traditional name for the day in Latin is Feria VI in Parasceve, which translates as "The Sixth Day of the Week of Preparation." Other languages make do with "Holy Friday." In another part of England, as in Denmark, the people used to call it "Long Friday," a good description for a quiet day without work and no chance for play or a good meal!

About Bishop Edward J. Burns

Bishop Burns comes to Dallas from the Diocese of Juneau, Alaska, where he has served as the bishop since 2009. Prior to that, the 59-year-old Pittsburgh, PA native served the Catholic Church on the national level as Executive Director of the Secretariat for Clergy, Consecrated Life and Vocations at the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops in Washington, D.C. from 1999-2008. In 2008, he was named the Rector of St. Paul Seminary in Pittsburgh, PA. Prior to 1999, Bishop Burns served in parish ministry, diocesan administration and did extensive work in vocations. Bishop Burns succeeds Cardinal Kevin J. Farrell, who left Dallas for Rome on October 1 after Pope Francis appointed him the Prefect of the new Vatican Dicastery for Laity, Family and Life.

Acerca del Obispo Edward J. Burns

El Obispo Burns viene a Dallas de la Diócesis de Juneau, Alaska, donde ha servido como obispo desde el año 2009. Antes de eso, el nativo de Pittsburgh, PA de 59 años ha servido en la Iglesia Católica a nivel nacional como Director Ejecutivo de la Secretaría del Clero, la Vida Consagrada y Vocaciones de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos en Washington, D.C. del 1999 al 2008. En 2008, fue nombrado Rector del Seminario Saint Paul en Pittsburgh, PA. Antes de 1999, el Obispo Burns sirvió en el ministerio parroquial, administración diocesana y realizó una extensa labor en las vocaciones. El Obispo Burns reemplaza al Cardenal Kevin J. Farrell, quien dejó a Dallas para dirigirse a Roma el 1ero. de octubre después que el Papa Francisco lo nombró Prefecto del nuevo Dicasterio Vaticano para los Laicos, la Familia y la Vida.
